

Bluebonnet Highlands – Council-only Meeting – March 12, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.

Officers were selected:

Kate provided an update regarding the street signs project. The Springlake side is almost complete. New signs will be installed in Fairhill next.

A discussion was held regarding the mailboxes in Springlake. The Council discussed the possibility of switching from cluster mailboxes to individual mailboxes, but the Post Office would require that all homes have individual mailboxes, if the cluster boxes were removed. The Council discussed the possibility of imposing a special assessment on Springlake to pay for individual mailboxes, but this discussion was tabled until more information is gathered. Kate will call the mailbox vendor to find out the cost to install individual mailboxes throughout Springlake.

Erin reported that she received three HIRs to extend driveways. These projects require City-Parish approval, in addition to Council approval. The Council approved the HIR for Theriot (SL-447) to extend his driveway.

Kate will get pricing and additional information regarding clearing out and maintaining the land between Hillbrook and Springtree near the BREC dog park,

The Council voted to approve pressure washing the entrance signs and restriping the parking lot.
